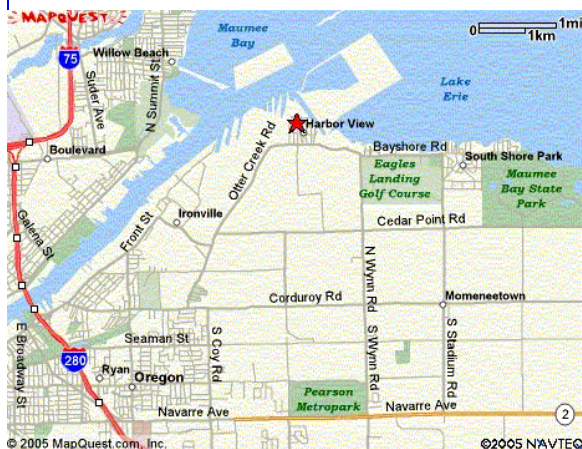

From the Pen of your Cdr Linda,

What a humbling experience it is to be your new Commander. Humbling and exciting, yet fully aware of knowing the great responsibilities that lie ahead.

As a member of the Toledo Sail and Power Squadron, I have always been encouraged to get involved in different aspects of our organization. The desire to learn more and more was (and is) an adventure that I enjoy very much. Moving through the ranks, taking (and passing) the many classes and seminars has broadened my knowledge and has inspired me to help encourage the need to educate and promote water safety and safe boating.

I have attended as many of the District conferences as possible, and they are a great way to meet and share ideas and experiences with other squadrons. These conferences are very informative and packed with ideas to share with our members. Please try to attend one of the District conferences and see for yourself what a great experience it is. For example, at the Fall Conference, we learned what the word Commander stands for. Commander means to Communicate often, Organize activities, Manage meetings, Monitor committees, Achieve goals, Notice details, Delegate tasks, Educate yourself, and Resolve conflict. (Believe me, I looked at those around me and thought "What in the world am I doing? Where is the nearest exit?") I apparently looked a little overwhelmed, because the person sitting next to me put their hand on mine and said, "It will be all right, you have plenty of support, you will be just fine."

Researchers have recorded the flight paths of individual birds by strapping tiny global

Migratory birds flock because it serves the purpose of aiding or assisting those who haven't made the trip before. When birds fly in flocks over long distances, it is actually more "fuel efficient" for them. The air turbulence created by the front of the flock makes it less strenuous for the trailing birds to fly. They even rotate positions to spread the benefit to the entire flock.

My purpose in discussing the idea of flocking together should start to make sense now. As individual members of the squadron (or any organization), we cannot do the work alone. We need to flock together, to help one another, to encourage one another, to build stronger relationships for the advancement of the squadron or any organization.

As Commander, I have the ultimate responsibility for leadership and management of the squadron. As Executive Officer, Lt/C Jason Snook is responsible for the external operations, our Educational Officer, P/C Larry Cole manages all of the education activities, our Administrative Officer, Lt/C Donald Dietz, is responsible for the internal affairs of the squadron. We cannot do this alone.

By flocking together and spreading our wings, we can facilitate networking and partnership formation among similar groups such as the ODNR, the USCGA, the Josh Project, and WLESBC and so on. By flocking together, we become stronger, more powerful and more united in our organization. Our mission, our goal, is to educate, promote and encourage water safety, and boating education and safety, to make our waterways a safe and fun-filled adventure.

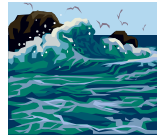

Pablo Prieto, Aug. 23, 1939-Dec. 20, 2010

Pablo Prieto, 71, of Huron, died early Monday morning, Dec. 20, 2010, in Cleveland Clinic, following a brief illness.

He was born Aug. 23, 1939, in Havana, Cuba, and arrived in America in 1960, when he began his career in the landing gear industry. He was part owner/operator of Metals Applied and was vice-president of operations for the Cleveland Pneumatic Company. He served as president of Menasco Aerospace LTD and later became group president of Coltec Industries, Landing Gear Group. He was serving as president and general manager of ATI Aviation Services.

Pablo was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church-Cleveland, the Medina Kennel Club, was an active member of the United States Power Squadron where he was serving as staff commander and held many offices on the national, district and local level. He was an instructor of celestial navigation for the Power Squadron.

He enjoyed his family and was a "ham" radio enthusiast. He also enjoyed diving, sailing and being out on the water. Pablo loved attending his grandchildren's sporting events.

Pablo is survived by his wife, Sharon (Kuppe) Prieto, whom he married April 4, 1964; his daughter, Amy (Joby) Pfeil of Vermilion; his son, Paul F. Prieto of Huron; grandchildren, Samantha, Savannah, Joby Jr., and Jonah Pfeil; his sister, Carmen (Armando) Valdes of Puerto Rico; and several nieces, nephews and other relatives.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Pablo and Flora (Canal) Prieto.

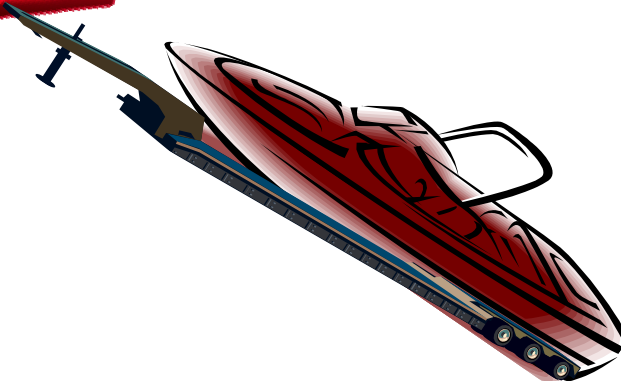
