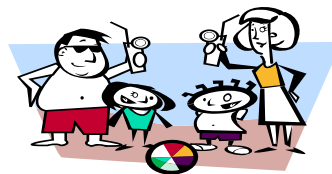

Please note that if we do not receive your returned card by the above date, you will no longer receive a hard-copy of *The Breeze* in the mail, only electronically.

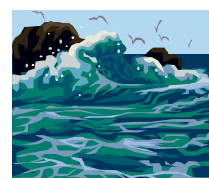
