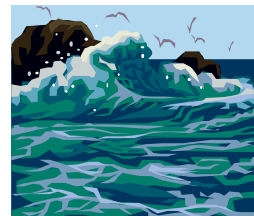

Here it is October and the end of another boating season. Now is the time to be thinking about taking a class or seminar to increase our boating handling knowledge and skills. Toledo Squadron is very fortunate to have many qualified instructors.

I am working to schedule a Piloting Class either still this year or the first of 2012. For those of you who have completed Seamanship, you will find the Piloting Class is the first course in the sequence of USPS courses on navigation, covering the basics of coastal and inland navigation. This course focuses on navigation as it is done on recreational boats today, and embraces GPS as a primary navigation tool while covering enough of traditional techniques so the student will be able to find his/her way even if their GPS fails. The course includes many in-class exercises, developing the student's skills through hands-on practice and learning.

We have an Engine Maintenance class planned for early next year. The new Engine Maintenance course has been put into one ten chapter course that stresses the diagnosis of modern systems, while also teaching the basics of engine layout and operation. Gasoline inboards, outboards, and diesel engines are taught in a way that reinforces the common aspects of how engines work. This new course is complete in one book with one exam. Please contact me if you are interested in this class.
